I would like to ask for your assistance in identifying Junior College athletes who are **American Indian/Alaskan Native, a member of a federally recognized tribe**, and capable of competing on the four year college level of competition. Haskell University is a member of the National Intercollegiate Athletic Association and competes in basketball on the division II level.

If you have student athletes who qualify, here is what Haskell University offers:

1. Haskell is tuition free. Semester fees of \$215.00 include housing, meals, and books.
2. Students who qualify for financial aid receive all financial aid benefits.
3. Quality education in an Associate of Arts or Bachelor's degree program.
4. Housing in a residence hall reserved for student athletes.

Requirements are set for transfer eligibility by the N.A.I.A. Before entering the third season of competition the transfer student must have passed 48 hours with a 2.00 G.P.A. Junior College transfer students must also have passed 24 hours during the previous two semesters with a 2.00 G.P.A.
