

CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

The Haskell Indian Nations University Code of Student Conduct emphasizes each student's individual responsibility for maintaining appropriate behavior while attending and representing the university. These are guidelines based on regulations and laws of the State of Kansas, ordinances of the City of Lawrence and regulations found in the Haskell Code of Student Rights and Responsibilities. **Knowledge of these regulations, laws and ordinances and Haskell Code of Student Conduct.**

- Students found in violation of the Zero Tolerance policy related to being intoxicated, possession and/or transportation and trafficking of alcohol or illegal drugs risk the loss of housing.
- The university will inform parents/guardians of students under the age of 21 upon receiving a report involving substance abuse.
- Violent or disruptive actions such as fighting, intimidation and unlawful assembly are not permitted on the Haskell campus and may result in emergency suspension from the campus.
- Theft of personal, private and/or institutional property will not be tolerated and may lead to legal prosecution.
- The use or possession of firearms or other lethal weapons are prohibited on campus and in the residential halls.
- Harassment based on gender, tribal affiliation, degree of Indian blood, sexual orientation, disability, marital or parental status or age is not tolerated.
- Show respect for property by not engaging in its defacement or destruction. Student will be liable for all costs associated with damage.
- Gambling is prohibited on the campus and at Haskell activities.
- Received Haskell Code of Student Conduct handbook and follow regulations.
- Trespassing on Haskell campus may result in issuance of a Criminal Trespass Form which could result in arrest and/or prosecution.
- Abide by all residential housing rules, this applies to all on and off campus students.
