## Steps to Studying Abroad

1. Meet with the International Education Committee  
Set-up a meeting time with an IEC member to discuss program options, study of interest, etc., to make your experience a great one.
2. Find the program best suited for you  
Look through the various packages available through your Haskell campus and the University of Kansas brochures.
3. Apply for a passport  
Visit the local post-office in Lawrence or your home community. Passports can take 4 to 6 weeks to process, so start now. You can also get passport information online at [http://travel.state.gov/passport/passport\\_1738.html](http://travel.state.gov/passport/passport_1738.html)
4. Check with the Financial Aid Office  
Meet with your financial aid officer about your plans to study abroad. Determine what adjustments, if any, are needed to ensure your funding for the academic year includes your study abroad program.
5. Apply  
Start processing your application before the noted deadlines. An application for Spring 2008 travel will have a date of January 10, 2008. Summer and Fall travel will have a deadline of March 1, 2008.
6. Familiarize yourself  
Enroll in the necessary courses for the program you intend on participating in. Attend the appropriate Saturday Seminar for your orientation information.
7. Pack your things, and enjoy a wonderful opportunity for cultural enrichment and academic exchange.
