Who are we?

The Student Support Services Program (under Haskell Student Services) provides eligible students with comprehensive, individualized support services in the areas of academic and personal need. The support provided is geared toward assisting disadvantaged students in successfully completing each semester to the best of their abilities.

Services Offered?

For eligible students, SSS offers:

- ◆ FREE individualized tutoring
- ◆ Drop-in tutoring, this can be used in addition to, or instead of scheduled tutoring
- ◆ Peer advising and/or graduation planning
- ◆ Limited financial assistance for Pell-eligible students with documented need

Services continued...

- ◆ Personal counseling
- ◆ Student advocacy
- ◆ Community resource acquisition
- ◆ Workshops on topics such as time management, study skills, test taking skills, writing, life skills
- ◆ Your own personal coordinator to help you coordinate all your resources, support and effort
- ◆ Campus visits to the University of Kansas

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for Haskell Indian Nations University-Student Support Services, you have to meet at least one of these requirements:

- ◆ A first-generation college student (meaning neither of your parents graduated from a 4-year degree program before you turned 18),

AND/OR

- ◆ A student whose family meets the federal guidelines for low income,

IN ADDITION

You must have a documented **academic need** such as:

- ◆ GED or low high school GPA
- ◆ Low college GPA or on academic probation
- ◆ ACT score less than 18
- ◆ Been out of the academic pipeline for 5 yrs

If you are not sure if you qualify under any of these criteria, please ask a TRiO-SSS Retention Specialist for further clarification.
